All members are reminded that as of 1st of January, the Post bartenders will be requesting 2012 proof of Legion membership of ALL members who request service, so please let's get with it and renew now, before year end PLEASE!! This goes for SAL and Auxiliary members as well. The Legion 180 member goal for the month of December is 75%, or 633 Legionnaires.
